Voting will take place Monday, June 20, 2011 between the hours of 6:00-8:00 pm. Each contestant will have her photo displayed at the voting table in the Community Room. The crowning of Miss Friendship 2011 will take place during opening ceremonies on Wednesday June 22, 2011. Contestants for Miss Friendship must agree to and sign the application form/contract to be eligible to win and possess the title of Miss Friendship for their entire reign. The winner of the Miss Friendship title will receive a crown, sash, flowers and a \$500 scholarship. Also, she will be riding in the festival grand parade on Sunday, June 26, 2011.

Bourbonnais Friendship Festival, Inc.—Miss Friendship 2011 Contestant Contract, General Rules and Guidelines

1. Contestants must be between the ages of 16-21 years of age at the time of the competition and of good moral character.
2. Contestants must be residents of the Village of Bourbonnais or Bourbonnais Twp.
3. Contestants must be single and remain single until the completion of her reign, or result in immediate disqualification and forfeit of all prizes, titles, trophies, etc.
4. All contestants must be at the main stage on the Festival Grounds by 5:30 pm on Wednesday June 22, 2011 for the festival Opening Ceremonies and the crowning of Miss Friendship 2011.
5. Each contestant will prepare a short, two minute acceptance speech to be given in the event that she is crowned Miss Friendship 2011.
6. The winner agrees to ride in the Festival Grand Parade on Sunday June 26th and promote Bourbonnais and the Friendship Festival in a positive manner throughout her reign. She also agrees to take part in activities as the reigning Miss Friendship, and come back to crown her successor the following year, or her title, crown, and scholarship money will be passed down to the runner up.
7. No refunds of entry fees, under any circumstances. No exceptions will be made.
8. All cash scholarship prizes will be awarded the following year, Friendship Festival 2011, after all obligations have been fulfilled.
9. Good sportsmanship is essential. The Bourbonnais Friendship Festival, Inc. will not tolerate any poor behavior by contestants, parents, or any member of the contestant's party. If there is any exhibition of poor sportsmanship, in any way or at any time, it will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of all prizes, fees, titles, trophies, etc.
10. Failure to comply with the rules and guidelines will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of all prizes, fees, titles, trophies, etc. A contestant's signature and/or parent's signature on the application indicate that both the parent/guardian and contestant understand the rules and guidelines and agree to abide by them.
